

WHY TRAIN WITH US?

- Our trainee outcomes are exceptionally high. Since the course began, all trainees that have completed the course and wanted to go into teaching, have gone on to find employment in schools within six months of graduating.
- As a single-subject SCITT we can really focus on developing your deep subject-specific knowledge and pedagogy in PE, as well as a strong understanding of the full primary curriculum.
- You will have the opportunity to gain a wide range of additional training, teachers' qualifications and sport specific NGB awards at no extra cost including: cricket, tennis, hockey, athletics, rugby, BEE netball, REAL PE, TOP Sport, Premier League Primary Stars, children and young people's mental health, forest school, phonics training and foundation subject enrichment opportunities.
- Training is completely school-centred. We work with over 25 schools in the North East and a significant number of these support the curriculum delivery.

 from your class teacher, school-based mentor, a link tutor and support

COURSE STRUCTURE

Both primary and secondary courses are delivered through 4 interleaved modules.



- Professional Studies Covering the fundamentals of teaching in a whole school setting and linked to an academic assignment as part of the PGCE.
- Curriculum Studies Developing subject knowledge of the full primary curriculum and applying fundamentals of Professional Studies to a PE specific context. Linked to an academic assignment as part of the PGCE.
- Professional Placement Developing mastery of the curriculum in contrasting school placements and meeting the Teachers' Standards leading to Qualified Teacher Status.
- Enquiry into Education Exploring evidence-based research with a focus on one specific class and the impact made on pupil progress as part of a small-scale action-based research project.
